Investigate & Construct

- **Science:** In Science, we will be looking at how life has evolved over millions of years to gain a real understanding if apes really are our ancestors!
- **PSHE:** Learning how we can keep healthy as we grow and exploring positive relationships and engagement in group activities.
- **PE:** Learn, practise and apply key skills in Hockey and gymnastics
- **Computing:** Coding, designing and de-bugging programs, using logical reasoning to explain algorithms.
- **RE:** We will be comparing Christian views to Scientific views.
