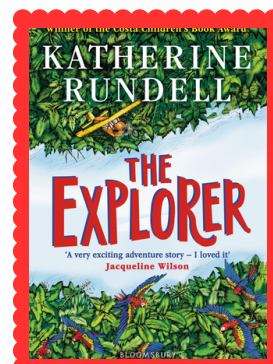
Sharing Assembly



Our Love of Reading text:

'The Explorer'.

When their plane crashes deep in the Amazon rainforest, Fred, Con, Lila, and Max are left all alone, miles from civilisation. With no adults to help, they must learn to survive in the wild — facing danger, making discoveries, and working together. As they explore the mysterious jungle, they find clues that suggest they're not the first people to have been lost there. Full of adventure, bravery, and friendship, The Explorer is an exciting story about courage and the spirit of discovery.



What is the Amazon like?

In Geography, we will be comparing our forest to UK forests and then to the Amazon Rainforest, using our locational skills to map, fieldwork opportunities, exploring the local area and completing a case study of Manaus and comparing it to our locality.

In Science, we will be looking at how we can make the most of our bodies. We will do this by looking at the circulatory system and how our heart keeps us alive.
