The Gruffalo and Friends!

Our class text this half term is 'The Gruffalo'

In Literacy this half term we are reading the story of "The Gruffalo". By looking at the story we will be discovering what animals live in the wood and the similarities and differences between them. We will be retelling the story by using pictures and actions on a "Story Map".

In Maths, we will be exploring number by discovering ways in which numbers can be split and combined using natural found objects. We will be practising our subitising skills to 5 (recognising a given amount without the need to count) and gaining an understanding of the concept of 'one more'. We will also be looking at shape and how they can be rotated/ manipulated.

In our topic work the children will be discovering animal habitats and the season of Winter. We will be learning all about the Christmas story and will be busy preparing for our own Christmas performance.

We do lots of activities outside. It is important that children bring a suitable coat to keep them dry and warm. Please practise fastening zips, putting on gloves etc so that children can do this independently and ensure all items are clearly labelled.



Reading is an essential part of the learning journey at The Crescent Academy. Your child will read in school every day. **It is essential that your child has their reading book and diary in school every day.** We use the diary to communicate with you about your child's reading progress.

We would appreciate it if you could leave a comment/ sign in the diary to let us know that you have read **at least 3 times each week** with your child at home. We are able to award children in school for their efforts during our Friday celebrations for super reading at home!
