- Jack sold his cow at the market. Have you been to a market before? Write or draw a shopping list of things you could buy at the market.
- Can you re-tell the story of Jack and the Beanstalk using actions and story words?
- Practise writing your name independently.



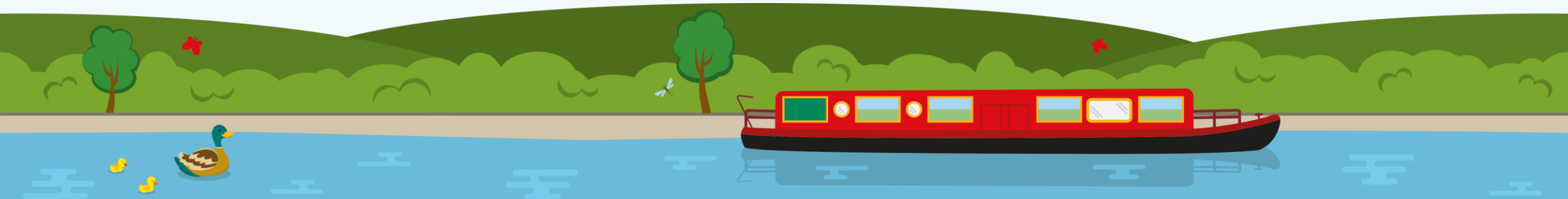
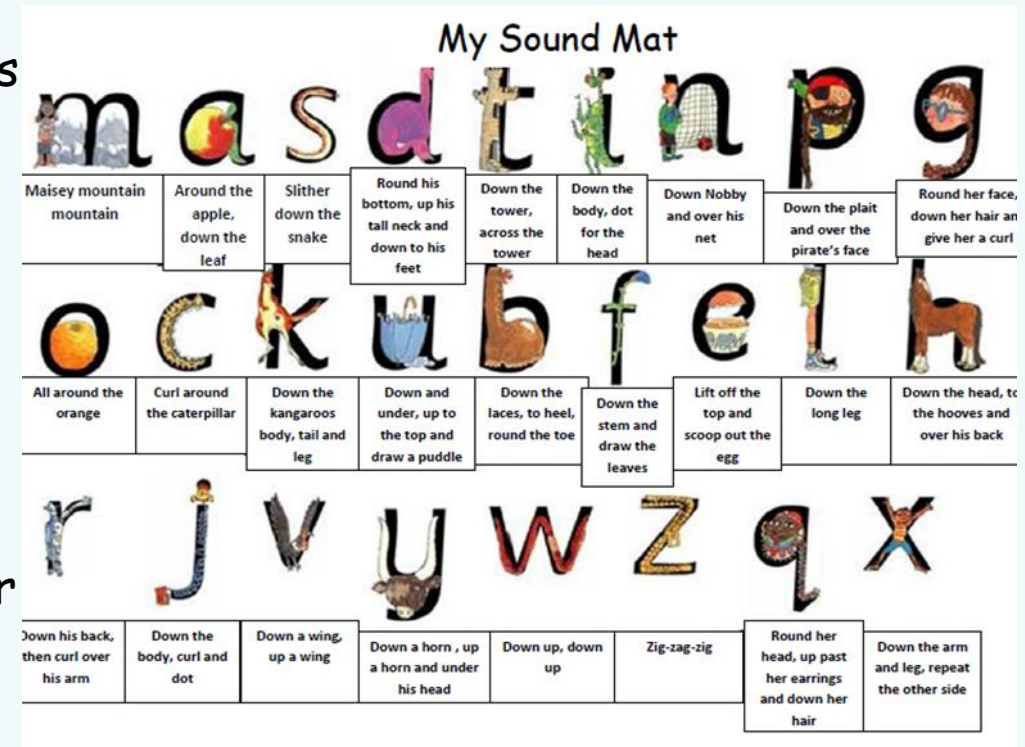
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We are practising our set 1 sounds and recognising them in words and writing them.

Try putting the sounds together to make a word such as d-o-g?

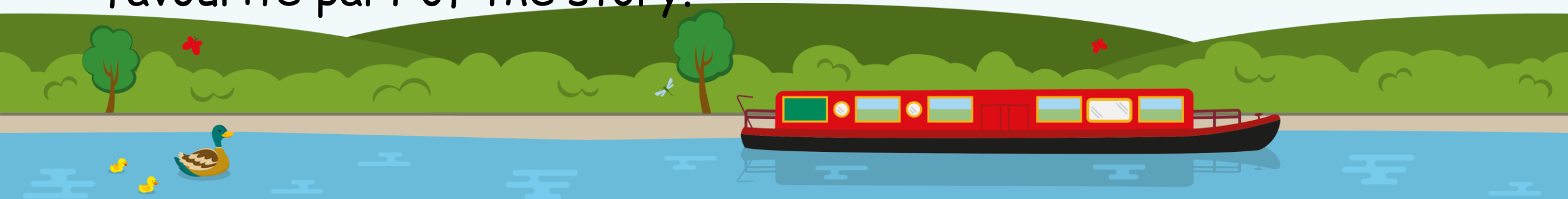
Don't forget to practise using the rhymes to help you write each letter correctly. You could use a brush and water and write the letters on the floor/ a fence. Watch them disappear before your eyes!



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Phonics – continued...

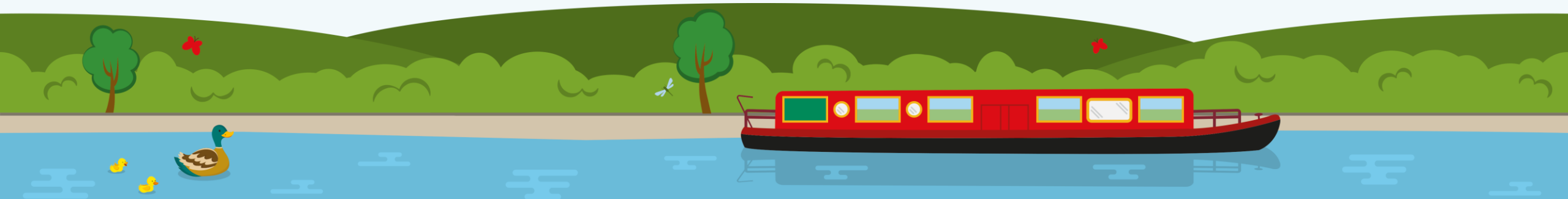
- Join in with some phonics games on Phonics Bloom-

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Maths – continued...

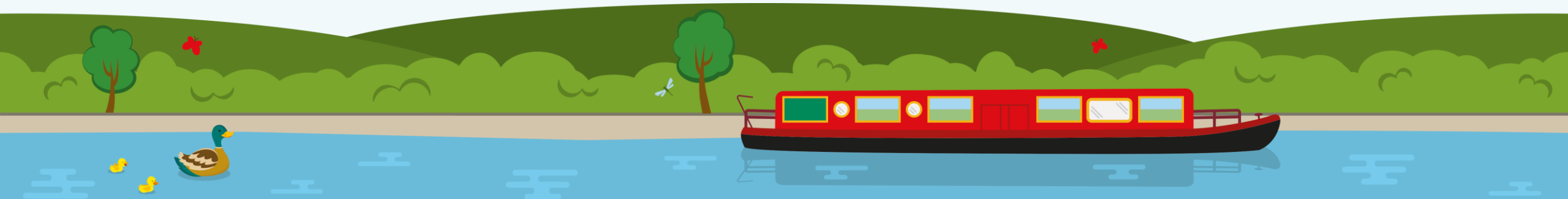
- We are learning about measurement and comparing length. Cut up some different sized pieces of ribbon or string. Can you order them from longest to shortest?
- Have a go at using different sized kitchen rolls and toilet rolls to decorate and turn into beanstalks– measure the different heights. Which is tallest?
- Find different sized shoes, boots and wellies in your house. Can you find matching pairs and compare the size and footprints. Extend by looking at different kinds of footprints. Which animal do you think would make the biggest footprint?
- Cut up apples/potatoes and print using paint to make different repeated colour patterns.
- Can you use cut up shapes to create a picture of a castle? Don't forget to add a flag!



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Reception Topic

- Use your recycling to make a castle. Think of different ways to join the recycling together.
- Make your own golden egg...use metallic paint or crunch up some real egg shells to collage with. Do you know where eggs come from?
- Plant your own “magic beans”. Take good care of them, water them daily and watch them grow into tall beanstalks!
- Imagine a giant beanstalk grew in your garden. Draw a picture of what it would look like and write about what you would like to find at the top!
- Draw a map to help Jack escape from the Giant’s castle.

What makes you feel happy?



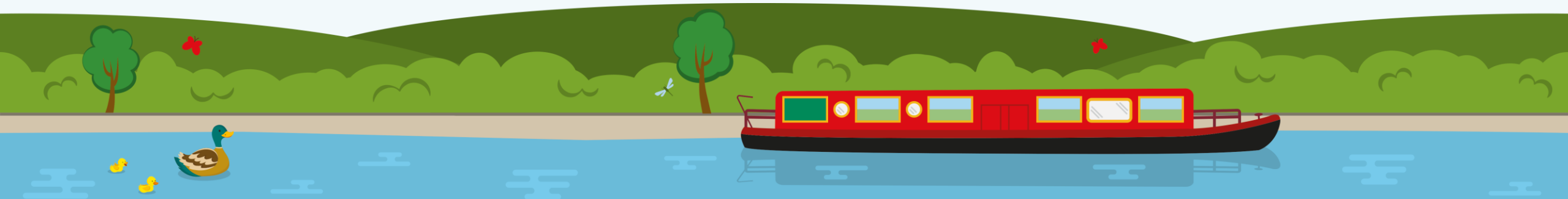
Make a paper plate face to show how you are feeling today.



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We are building up our muscles to improve our pencil grip!

- Practise your cutting skills with supervision of an adult. Try cutting different textures such as cooked spaghetti!
- Practise zipping up your coat.
- Go to Dough Disco on Youtube to dance with your playdough!
- Draw out some patterns and find objects to place over the top... such as buttons or stickers!
- Write your name using finger paints or dab on paint using cotton wool buds.
- Make a washing line and use pegs to hang up pairs of socks !



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PE



- Join in with some cosmic yoga on cosmickids.com
- Practise moving around in different ways. Such as, bouncing, hopping, crawling, on tip toes, shuffling.
- Blow up a balloon and practise throwing and catching it.
- Try using different actions from the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk' to act it out... chopping, running, climbing etc.
- Make a target with numbers on and practise rolling objects (such as a dice/ marbles) onto it.
- Draw out a hopscotch using chalk, throw a pebble to land on a number and hop on each number until you land at your pebble.
