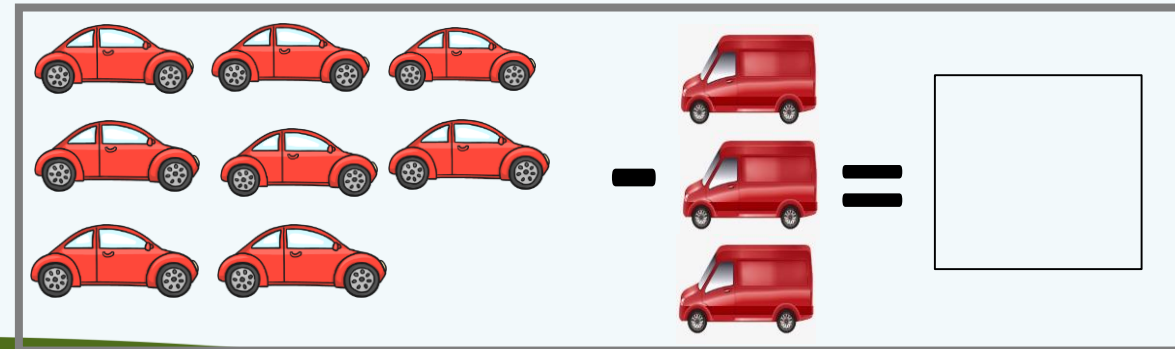
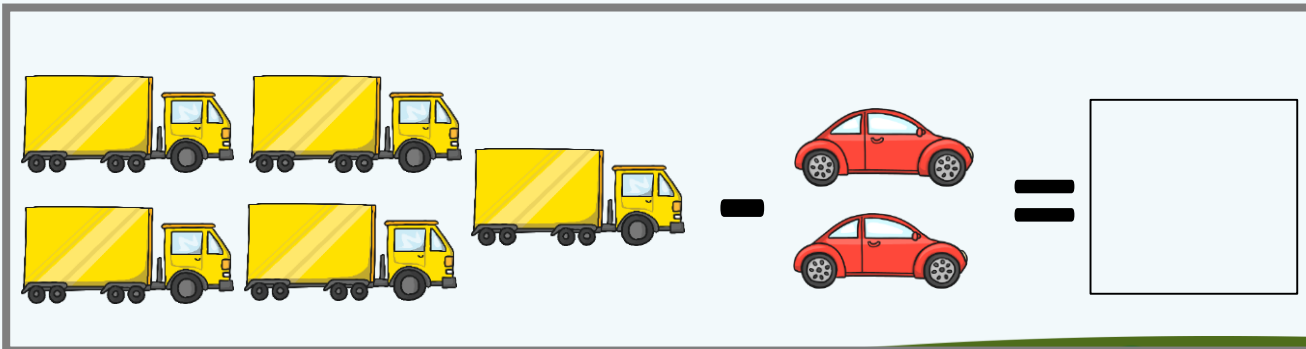
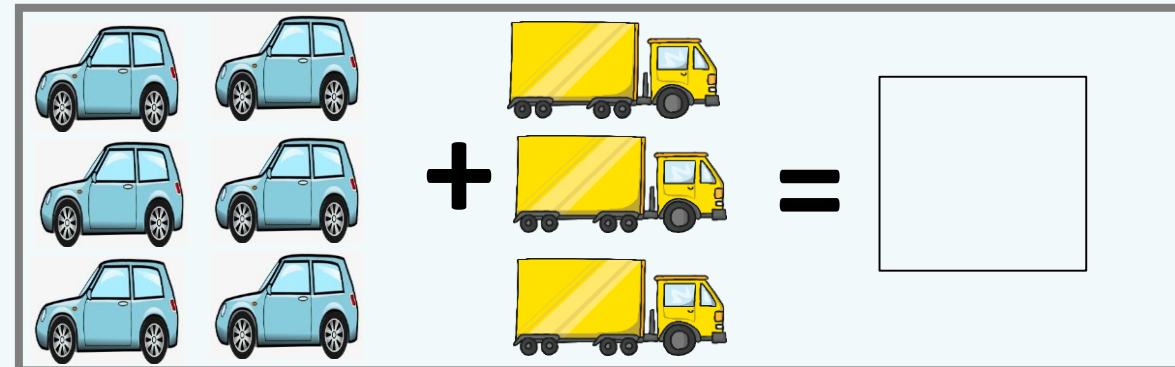
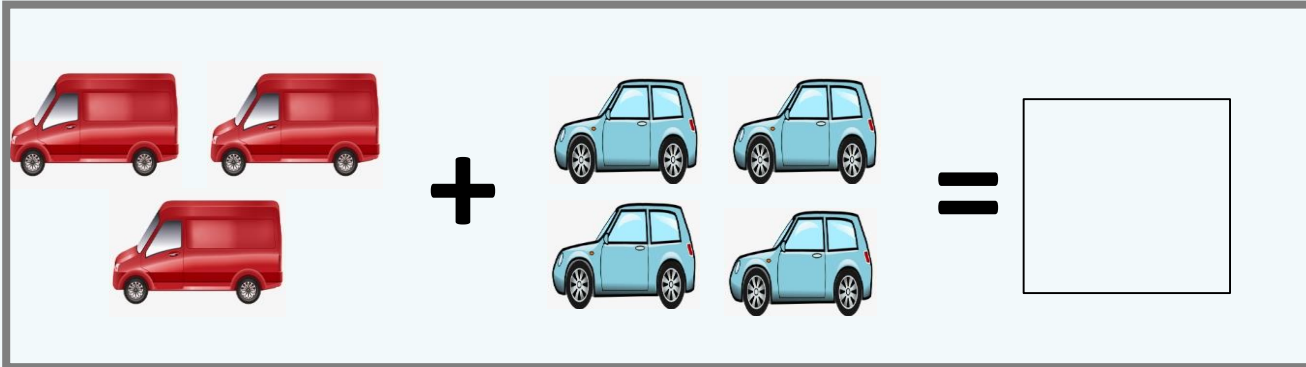
- Where does the train go? Write down/ draw what they see from the train.

Maths – We are focusing on adding and subtracting within 10!

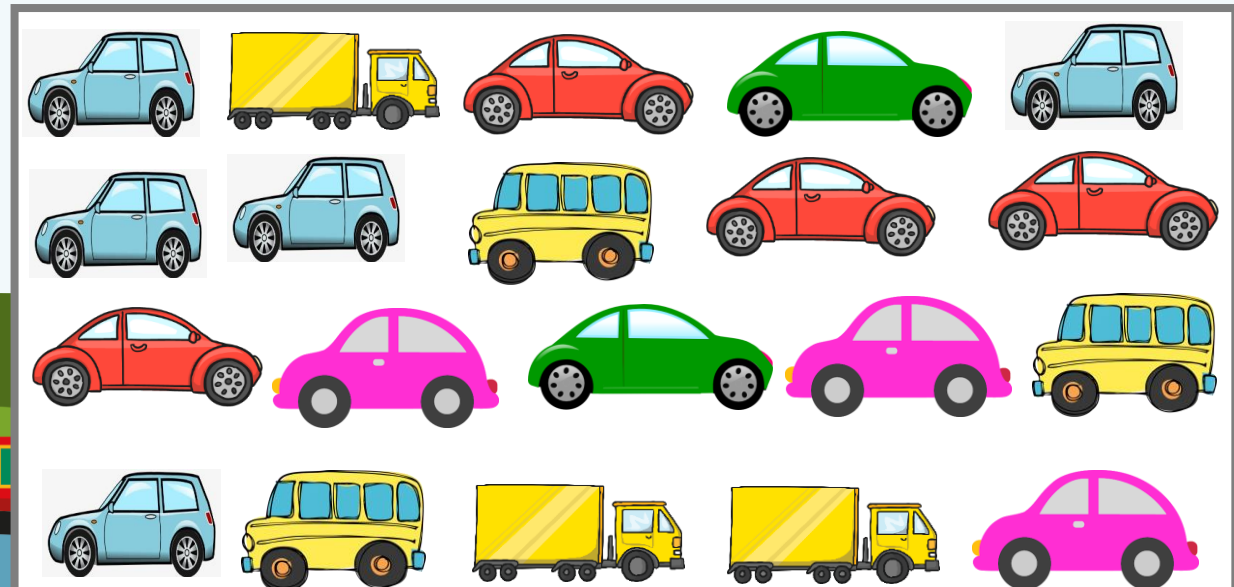

How many would there be left if I took away all of the blue vehicles?

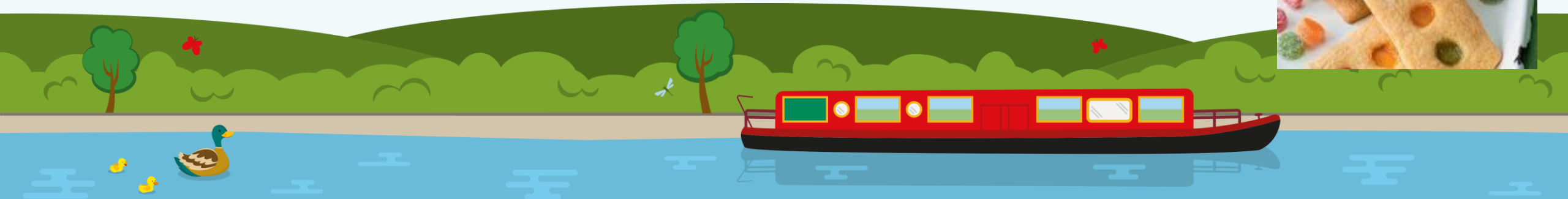


Can you count all the way to 20?

The Train Journey - Topic

The Train Journey – Topic continued

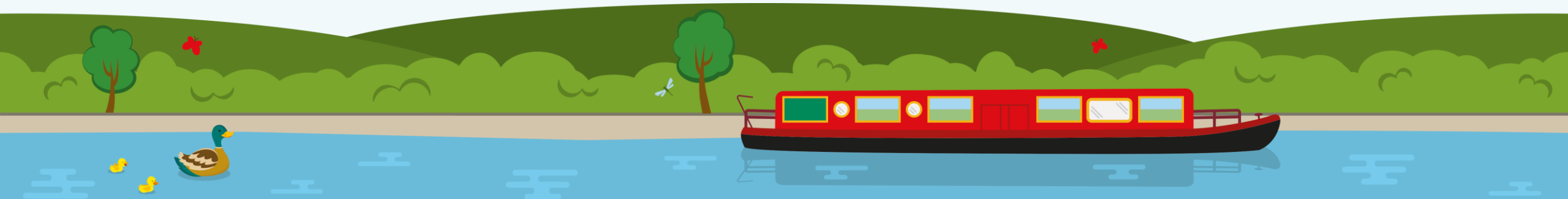
- This half term is pancake day. Design a pancake and the toppings you'd like and then make it. Can you flip your pancake in the frying pan?

We are learning about Chinese New Year

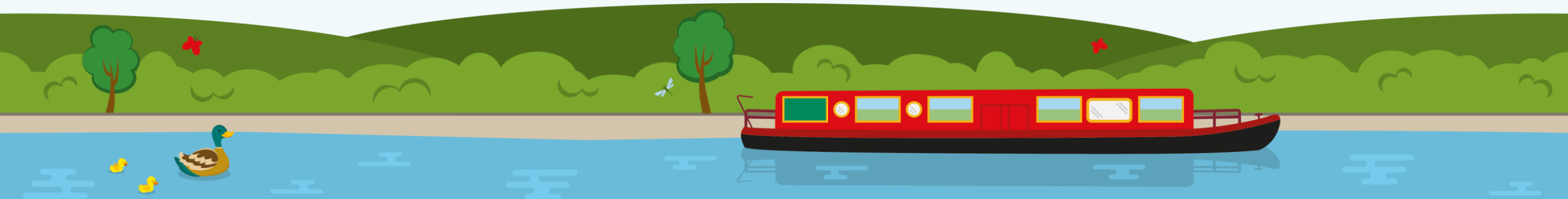
- We are finding out about the Year of the Tiger.

- Make a Chinese New Year card for a friend.
- Draw a blossom picture, fold into a fan and dance to Chinese music.
- Have a go at writing using a brush with paint or water.
- Draw animal pictures and act out the "Great Race".



Continuing the Learning Journey at home: Reception

We are building up our muscles to improve our pencil grip!

- Practise attaching pegs to the washing line or a piece of card. How many can you do in 1 minute?
- Make some playdough by mixing ingredients by hand (lots of recipes online).
- Go to Dough Disco on Youtube to dance with your playdough!
- Thread shoelaces through the holes in shoes. Learn how to tie laces up.
- Practise putting on and off your coat, pull up zips etc. Try and get dressed each day all by yourself!
- Pour some flour, salt or icing sugar onto a tray or table top. Practise writing your name, letter sounds and numbers.



Continuing the Learning Journey at home: Reception

PE – Give your muscles a stretch!

- Find a space where you can walk or run safely. Practise stopping and starting and changing direction.
- How many jumps, hops, spins, touching your toes can you do in 1 min, 2 mins and 3 minutes.
- Practise bouncing a ball.
- Practise throwing and catching a ball, beanbag or toy.
- Play skittles, make your own out of empty bottles, tins or cartons. Can you knock them all down. Play a game with someone else.
